## QUICK MINDS FOR UKRAINE. TEACHING LETTER COMBINATIONS



Very often, students experience confusing letters or letter combinations. As the teachers say, students might have problems reconciling letters 'b' and 'd', or letter combinations 'sh' and 'ch'.
Here is an activity that will help your students remember the difference and also have fun.

## CORNER GAME

- You will need clear space. You might also do the exercise in a school yard or gym.
- Write the letters that students confuse on separate papers of 2 different colours - 2 identical sets, so you have 4 papers in total. For example: $\mathrm{CH} \times 2$ and $\mathrm{SH} \times 2$.
■ Stick the papers to the walls in 4 corners of the room.
■ Divide the class into 2 teams referring to their colour.
- Once you read out a word, 1 pupil from each team has to run to the relevant paper of their team's colour.
- The one who gets to the correct letter first - gets an extra point. If the letter is wrong - no points.

■ Pupils go one by one. You might also let the whole team go to the letters if the class is not too big.
