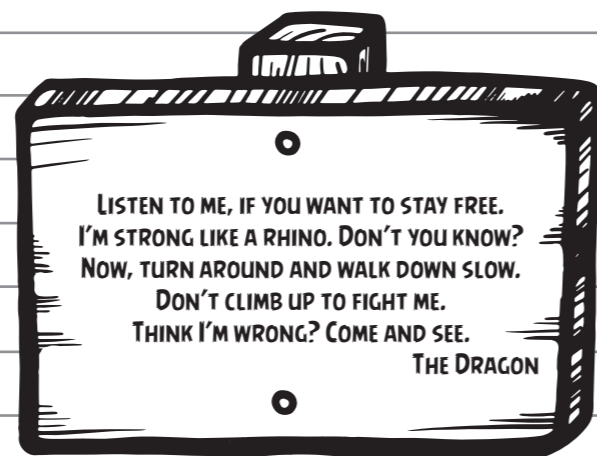


3 Eating out
