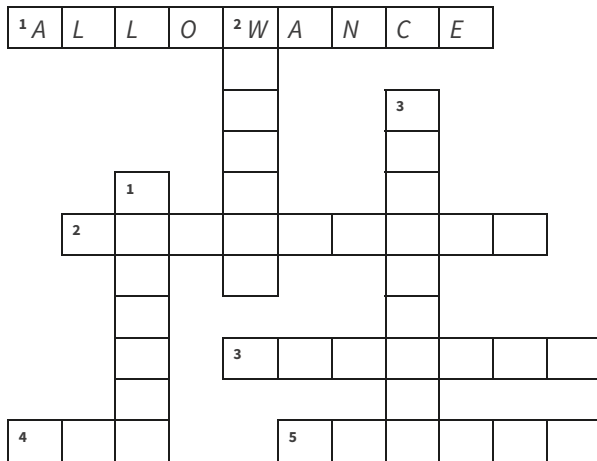


### 1 Use the clues to complete the crossword.

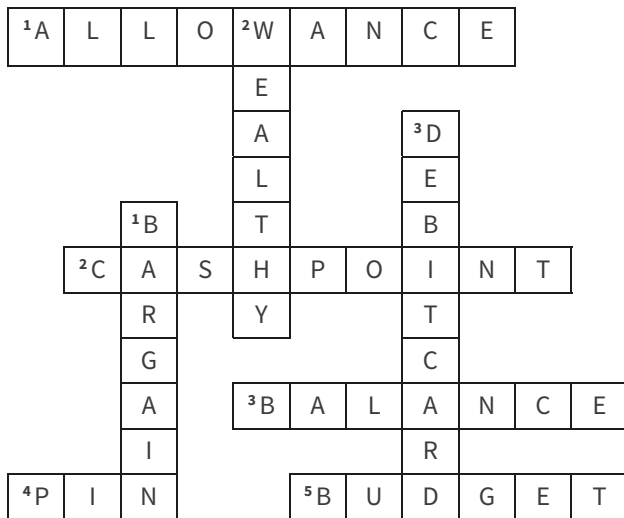
