

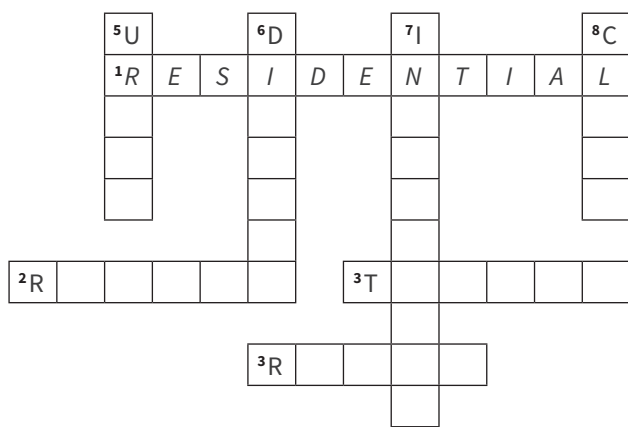
### 1 Complete the crossword puzzle.
