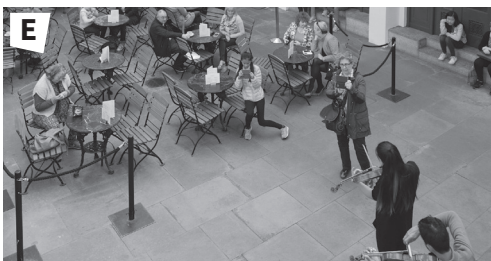
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3 02 Match the pictures from the video (a–e) with the information (1–8). Then watch again and check your answers.
