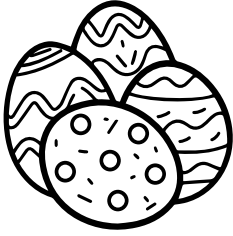

5. Why did the lazy Easter Bunny grow anxious as Easter approached?

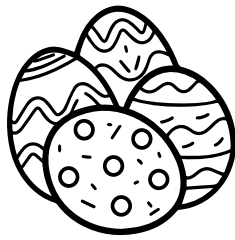
6. When did the snail finally show up with the materials for the baskets?
